Dear Cornelia; I know you will welcome some suggestions and advice, relating to this gift of stock, which may later be followed by other gifts (not necessarily divided in the ratio of this first gift - but varying, perhaps with the success and results of this "Starter".

The same anxiety and care which made this gift possible, prompts the following suggestions:

The will, your father is the safest custodian of your voting proxy at all stockholders meetings - "Unity = strength"

In all transactions and writings, carefully maintain this as your separate property (as distinguished from Community)

The earnings or dividends may be sufficient for Community uses or your children.

Your Will should be drawn, naming this as your separate property.

In appreciation and acknowledgement to the donors, you may think it wise to will $\frac{1}{2}$ your separate property to your children and $\frac{1}{2}$ to your mother and me, appointing Stanley and me and your mother - executors and Executrix, respectively, to act without bonds.

This we think, should insure against all possible disappointments; not for this alone, but for future like commitments. I am sending you a Law Pamphlet to instruct you in drawing Wills - Make it Holographic - No lawyer needed, - and, thus drawn, the will may be later substituted, or altered as you wish, and as often as need be to suit any conditions hereafter arising.

The present good health of your mother and me promise us another decade of Soviet labor for you all.
